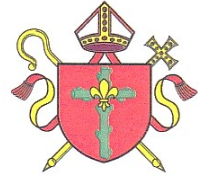

### **MISSIONARY DISCIPLESHIP**

**Missionary People:** Pope St. John Paul II in his Apostolic Exhortation on the mission and vocation of the lay faithful in the Church and the world, *Christifides Laici*, wrote that the laity 'are called to allow the newness and the power of the gospel to shine out every day in their family and social life, as well as to express patiently and courageously in the contradictions of the present age their hope of future glory even "through the framework of their secular life". We are called to be leaders in various ways in our parish/school and witnesses in our ordinary life. Not every lay person is called to work for the church, but every lay person is called to work for Christ.
