### **Message from Father Paul Okello Wandera from Uganda**

Most of you will know me following my visit to Holy Cross last year from the Diocese of Jinja in Uganda. I come from a family of 6 (3 boys and 3 girls). I was ordained a priest on the 15<sup>th</sup> August 2009 and I am currently working as the Diocesan Chancellor, Secretary, Pastoral Coordinator and parish priest of our Lady of Fatima Parish Jinja with a population of about 8,000 Christians with only about 3000 active Christians, 4 priests, with 4 Masses on Sunday. We have 7 schools and 18 Out Stations. The parish is located around the shores of Lake Victoria and the source of the River Nile. The parish has many vocations to the priesthood. However, most of the candidates come from very poor families and yet they are required to pay certain tuition to the seminary from their parents and parishes towards the seminary training for six years for the minor seminary and 8 years in the major seminary.

Currently, Our Lady of Fatima Parish has seminarians, most of whom come from a poor and needy background. Therefore, most of the candidates cannot continue with studies in the seminary because of lack of fees and other scholastic materials. Each seminarian is required to pay **£500** every year to the seminary. We have lost many of our candidates to the priesthood because of lack of tuition and scholastic materials.

Similarly, in Fatima Parish we also have a lot of orphans and needy children who have lost their parents due to HIV/AIDS. Most of these children have no one to take care of their education and other basic needs. They resort to coming to the parish begging for support and guidance. With our little income as a parish, we cannot help them at all and yet we would like to save their life and build up for them a bright future through education and other technical trainings.

Any assistance given will be highly welcomed. You may channel your help through the parish priest Fr. Paul Chipchase, the parish secretary Vivien Flynn **or you may contact me until 11<sup>th</sup> August 2019 when I return to Uganda.** Great appreciation to Fr. Paul Chipchase for allowing me to share with you our situation in Uganda. May God bless you all.
