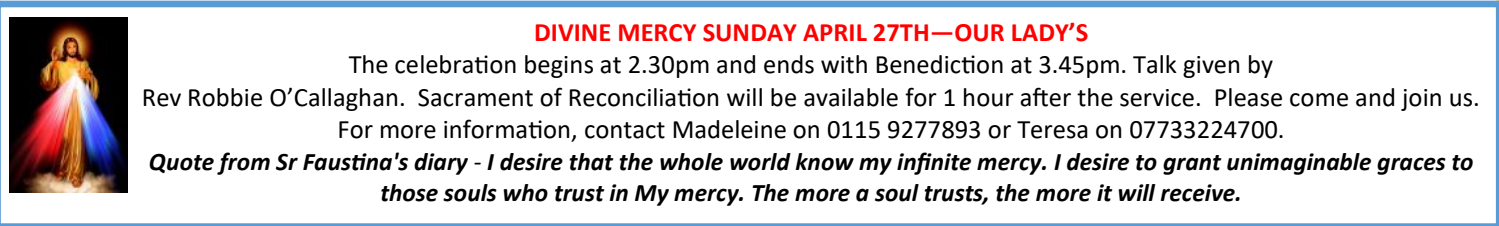

During Lent, we prepared ourselves through works of penance, prayer and Christian charity, in order to approach Easter with hearts and minds raised up to God with Christ Jesus as our focus and goal.
